

COVID-19 Testing Information

Always start with the person's family doctor/primary care physician. The doctor will provide an assessment and determine if testing is warranted. If person does not have a doctor, or the turn-around time for an appointment is going to be too long, the options we know of are below:

Pop-Up Testing – Call Public Health's COVID Information Line at 937-225-6217 to get a list of the latest pop-up sites available to the public.

Premier Health COVID Testing

If the person **already has a doctor's order from a Premier-affiliated doctor**, they can go to one of the below testing sites. Results will be in MyChart and they accept all types of insurance.

- i. OnMain** (old Montgomery County Fairgrounds, 1229 S. Main St. Dayton, OH)
 - Do NOT need an appointment. Go any time Monday – Friday, anytime between 10am – 5pm. Set-up as drive-thru.
 - OnMain site will also test those individuals who have a doctor's order and need tested for travel, return to work testing, assisted living placement, and those that have been exposed to someone that has tested positive, even if you're not showing symptoms.
- ii. Premier Health Urgent Care Miamisburg** (8 Prestige Plaza, Miamisburg)
 - Open between 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.
 - This site is for COVID testing only - It is not currently operating as a fully functional Urgent Care
 - Make an appointment for the test, pending you have an order from a Premier doctor.
 - When you arrive for your appointment, remain in your car and call (937) 208-6871 when you arrive. A staff member will meet you at the door. The test will be performed in the Atrium doorway.
- iii. Premier Health Urgent Care Vandalia** (6700 Commerce Center Dr. Vandalia)
 - Open between 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.
 - This site is for COVID testing only - It is not currently operating as a fully functional Urgent Care.
 - Make an appointment for the test, pending you have an order from a Premier doctor.
 - When you arrive for the appointment, remain in your car and call (937) 208-6875 when you arrive. A staff member will meet you at the door. The test will be performed in the Atrium doorway.
- iv. There are 2 other sites (outside Montgomery County) - Atrium Medical Center in Middletown, and Upper Valley Medical Center in Troy.**

If the **person does NOT have a doctor's order and needs tested** – certain Premier Urgent Care locations are offering COVID-19 testing. Appointments are needed, and the person will be clinically assessed before testing is ordered. www.premierhealth.com/locations/urgent-care and click "Schedule Urgent Care" on the right-hand side; or remain in your car and call once you're at the site to check-in. You need an ID & insurance and will have an urgent care co-pay. They do NOT accept Medicaid; and do not have the Care Act to cover cost for those uninsured. Locations include:

Kettering Health Network COVID Testing

For patients of Kettering Health Network only who already have a doctor's order from a Kettering-affiliated provider. Testing at the below locations is for patients requiring pre-admission testing; symptomatic & non-symptomatic patients; and KHN symptomatic employees. Test is a self-administered swab. Locations include:

- i. Southview Medical Center** – 1997 Miamisburg-Centerville Rd. Washington Twp, OH; 7am-5pm M-F; 8am-2pm Sat.-Sun.
- ii. Huber Health Center**, 8701 Old Troy Pike, Huber Heights, OH; 7am-5pm M-F; 8am-2pm Sat.-Sun.

If you do NOT have a doctor's order from a Kettering-affiliated provider, you can schedule an appointment at one of Kettering's Respiratory Care locations. Appointments can be scheduled online at <https://www.ketteringhealth.org/coronavirus/respiratory-care.cfm>. Patients must be seen by the provider at these locations before a test will be performed. It can take 24-72 hours for the results to be returned.

- ii. Englewood** - 1250 W. National Rd., Ste 450, Englewood, OH 45322
- iii. Washington Township** - 1028 Miamisburg Centerville Rd, Dayton, OH 45459

- a.** Must have an appointment. Call one of the below locations:
 - i.** North Dayton – 3602 N. Main St. Dayton, OH 45405, 937-963-1990
 - ii.** Englewood – 7709 Hoke Rd. Englewood, OH 45315, 937-836-4000
 - iii.** Kettering – 3604 Wilmington Pike, Kettering, OH 45429, 937-294-0066
- b.** Whether or not they will test you is based on a clinical assessment
- c.** Do accept insurance. If no insurance, they have the COVID-19 Care Act to help with payment
- d.** Englewood location also offers antibody testing

Doctor's Urgent Care

- a.** Visit www.amcare.com
- b.** see red box "Telehealth Services," speak with doctor, then you choose location after speaking to a doctor
- c.** drive-thru testing
- d.** Not free – billed to insurance or if uninsured, pay by cash or credit card

Equitas Health

- a.** Call 937-853-3650 to schedule an appointment. Located at 1222 S. Patterson Blvd. Suite 230, Dayton, OH and is drive-thru testing.
- b.** Billed to insurance or if uninsured, they operate on a sliding fee scale based on income or COVID Care Act

CVS Pharmacy

- e. Visit www.cvs.com
- f. Will complete an online assessment (**testing only for those symptomatic*). If the assessment says you need a test, you'll register for the drive-thru test site at:
 - i. 5981 Far Hills Ave. Dayton, OH
 - ii. 710 N. Main St. Springboro, OH
- g. Test will be self-administered in your car with oversight from an employee.
- h. Billed to insurance or free to those without insurance

Rite Aid Pharmacy

- a. Visit www.riteaid.com
- b. Complete a brief questionnaire and then if the assessment deems you need a test, you'll be able to schedule an appointment.
- c. 3875 Salem Ave, Dayton, OH 45406 is the only local location for appointments.
- d. Free of charge to anyone 18 y/o and older

Walgreens Pharmacy

- a. Visit www.walgreens.com
 - b. Choose "Coronavirus Questions" in the top blue bar and then click "See if You're Eligible"
 - d. Complete online screening to see if you're eligible and then if you're eligible, you'll schedule an appt.
 - e. 1402 Miamisburg Centerville Rd. Centerville, OH is the only local location for appointment and is set-up as a drive-thru test.
 - f. You'll receive results from PWNHealth

Antibody Testing through CompuNet

- Available for \$65 at all CompuNet Patient Service Centers
- Checks and credit cards accepted. For self-ordered labs, insurance cannot be billed
- No appointment needed
- Need to print an order form – visit CompuNet's website at compunetlab.com. Take completed form with you to any Patient Service Center along with picture ID and payment
- Do not come to facility if you currently have symptoms; should be symptom-free for at least 10 days
- Results will be ready w/in a couple days on My Labs Now. Results will also be mailed within 10 days.
- NOTE: a positive result for antibody does not necessarily imply immunity from COVID. Whatever the result, individuals should continue to follow guidance for social distancing and other recommended behaviors
