
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
# MEET

- He tried out for the varsity team as a sophomore but was cut because they considered him too small and not skilled enough.
- Not making the team inspired him to work harder; he made the team the next year and ended up going to North Carolina for college.





#### **COLLEGE CAREER**

- Michael Jordan only played basketball in college for three years: 1981-82 season
- He was the fourth player in North Carolina history to start his first game as a freshman.

#### WHEN HE GOT DRAFTED

- Michael Jordan got drafted in 1984 to the Chicago Bulls at the age of 21
- He emerged as a league star
- He also entertained the crowds with his prolific scoring while gaining a
  reputation as one of the best defensive players.





#### **HOW HE STARTED HIS SHOE**

- The Air Jordan shoes were created with Michael Jordan in mind during his time with the Chicago Bulls.
- Nike wasn't Jordan's first choice.
- The logo Jumpman wasn't there from the beginning.

#### WHEN THEY STARTED GOING VIRAL

- His shoes were released to the public on April 1st 1985.
- Michael Jordan sold four million pairs of shoes when they first got released to the public.





#### WHAT IS THE MOST EXPENSIVE JORDAN SOLD

• The Solid Gold Ovo x Air Jordan was sold for 2.2 million dollars.

#### HOW MANY SHOES HAVE BEEN SOLD SINCE APRIL 1ST 1985

• Over 4 million pairs sold the first year so its way more sold than the first year.




# National Championship Win!


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# How do Bear Facts students feel about the possible Tik Tok ban?



- January 19, 2025 The final deadline for ByteDance to sell TikTok. If it does not sell, TikTok will be banned in the United States.
- January 19, 2025 TikTok shuts down operations in the US. Users trying to access the app are met with a message saying TikTok isn't available right now.
- January 19, 2025 Roughly 12 hours after shutting down operations, TikTok makes a statement that it will "work with President Trump on a long-term solution that keeps TikTok in the United States".
- January 20, 2025 On his first day in office, President Trump signs executive order delaying the ban for 75 days and instructing the US Attorney General not to enforce the law. However the apprenains unavailable on app stores.
- February 13, 2025 TikTok returns to Apple and Google app stores in the US. President Trump says that the 75-day ban on TikTok could be extended.
