

COVID-19 QUARANTINE GUIDELINES REVISED 12/2020



Per the "Ohio Schools COVID-19 Evaluation Executive Summary" released 12/20/20, **STUDENTS INSIDE A CONTROLLED CLASSROOM SETTING ARE NOT REQUIRED TO QUARANTINE IN THE EVENT OF CLOSE CONTACT EXPOSURE WHEN ALL STUDENTS ARE WEARING MASKS** (within 6' for 15 minutes).

TRADITIONAL 14 DAYS (From last exposure)	 <u>FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF</u> FOR STUDENTS/STAFF WHO LIVE WITH SOMEONE WHO TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 - <u>14 DAYS FROM LAST EXPOSURE TO POSITIVE CASE</u> If positive case cannot isolate in home, last day of exposure will be positive case's 10th day of quarantine - this means quarantine MIGHT last up to 24 days
REVISED DURATION 1 10 DAYS	 FOR STUDENTS (AND STAFF NOT TESTED FOR REVISED DURATION 2) REVISED DURATION 1 WILL BE USED FOR STUDENTS WHO HAVE CLOSE CONTACT EXPOSURE NOT IN THE HOME Families may elect to use 14 day quarantine - all 14 days will be EXCUSED Students will be checked for symptoms upon school arrival days 11-14.
REVISED DURATION 2 7 DAYS	 FOR STAFF ONLY! REVISED DURATION 2 WILL BE USED FOR STAFF WHO HAVE CLOSE CONTACT EXPOSURE NOT IN THE HOME REVISED DURATION 2 requires a negative Covid-19 test ON DAY 5 OR AFTER of quarantine. If staff is unable to test, then REVISED DURATION 1 will be used - 10 days

ANY STUDENT/STAFF WHO DEVELOPS COVID-19 SYMPTOMS DURING QUARANTINE SHOULD BE TESTED AND COMPLETE THE REQUIRED 10 DAY ISOLATION PERIOD FOR COVID-19
